

## NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (NO.1)

Re: Specification of plants, plant pests or carriers from certain sources as prohibited materials, of exceptions and conditions under the Plant Quarantine Act, B.E.2507

By virtue of Section 6 of the Plant Quarantine Act, B.E. 2507, the Minister of Agriculture hereby specifies the plants, plant pests or carriers from certain sources as prohibited materials, exceptions and conditions as follows:

Plants in the genus <u>Oryza</u> such as rice, glutinous rice, Khao-la-man ( <u>O. latifolia</u> ), wild rice ( <u>O. granulata</u> ), etc. and the following carriers: raw rice paste and rice sprouts. Where prohibited materials are allowed to be imported for the purpose of experimentation or research, they must be handled according to the technique the Director-General deems appropriate.
