Re. Specification of plants or carriers as restricted materials, of exceptions and conditions under the Plant Quarantine Act, B.E. 2507

By virtue of Section 6 of the Plant Quarantine Act, B.E. 2507, the Minister of Agriculture hereby specifies the plants or carriers as restricted materials, exceptions and conditions as follows:
